Jenn Phillips joined the Ocean Protection Council and the California Natural Resources Agency in 2015 and is the program lead on ocean acidification and hypoxia and the Council's work on climate change and fisheries. Before OPC, she worked in the NOAA Administrator's Office where she started as a Sea Grant Fellow and then spent a year on the Administrator's staff. During this time, she helped with the development of NOAA's priorities, such as community resilience, and managed the associated communication and outreach. Jenn received her master's from the Nelson Institute for Environmental Studies at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2012 and her B.S. in Biology from Cornell University in 2009. Her graduate research explored the potential impacts of acidification of the Great Lakes through modelling, analysis of long-term data, and community surveys.
