I am a research fish biologist for the National Marine Fisheries Service, Southwest Fisheries Science Center, located in Santa Cruz. As a member of the Salmon Assessment Team at the Santa Cruz Lab, my work includes providing scientific support to salmon fishery management and performing research on salmon dynamics, assessment, and ecology. I currently serve on the Pacific Fishery Management Council's Salmon Technical Team, an advisory body that collectively performs stock assessments and works with fishery managers to plan salmon fisheries on an annual basis. With collaborators, I perform annual stock assessments for Klamath River fall Chinook, Sacramento River fall Chinook, and Sacramento River winter Chinook salmon. My education includes a B.S. from UC Davis, M.A. from San Francisco State University, and a Ph.D. (Ecology) from UC Davis.
